Dr. Sahas was also presented with the "Excellence in Individual Healthcare Professional" Award by the Greater Fort Lauderdale Chamber of Commerce at their Excellence in Healthcare Awards Luncheon, held on November 2, 2017.

Dr. Sahas, also a distinguished fellow of the American Psychiatric Association, is currently the Medical Director of Henderson Behavioral Health which is one of the oldest and largest providers of community behavioral health services in South Florida. As a board certified child psychiatrist, she serves as consultant to several organizations that provide care to children in child welfare such as Camelot Community Care, Kids in Distress, and the National Youth Advocate Program (NYAP). Dr. Sahas has served as one of the medical consultants for the University of South Florida Medicaid Drug Therapy Management Program and has helped create and revise Florida Best Practice Psychotherapeutic Medication guidelines for children, adolescents, and adults. She serves on various committees and panels, is a member of the Medical Directors Committee for the National Council for Behavioral Health, and a member of Sunshine Health's Child Welfare Advisory Committee. Dr. Sahas is also actively involved in training and mentorship to medical students from Nova Southeastern University College of Osteopathic Medicine.
