Dr. Marlene Freeman will discuss the course of mood disorders across pregnancy and the postpartum, and treatment considerations that take into account reproductive safety during pregnancy and breastfeeding.

Dr. Marlene Freeman is the Associate Director of the Perinatal and Reproductive Psychiatry Clinical Research Program at Massachusetts General Hospital and an Associate Professor of Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Freeman's clinical and research experience has been focused on antenatal and postpartum depression, as well as integrative treatment strategies for mood disorders.

Dr. Freeman established the University of Arizona's Women's Mental Health Program in 2000 and directed the program for seven years. She developed a research program in perinatal depression with grant support from NARSAD, the National Institute of Mental Health, the U.S. FDA, the Arizona Disease Control Research Commission, and the Institute for Mental Health Research. These grants supported research in perinatal depression. From 2007-2008, she served as the Director of the Women's Mental Health Center at UT Southwestern Medical Center.
